Dear Parishioners, Greetings of peace and joy! Stewardship weekend was successful: about 200 people came to the hall, and about 60 people signed up to join ministries/societies in the parish. Thanks to all and welcome to new volunteers/members.

We have set up a Finance and Building Committee as well as a Parish Pastoral Council. So far, we have had two meetings for each of the groups. Thank you to all members.

Our Screening Committee has been working hard. They have handed out about 200 screening packages for volunteers. Their work is helping us to provide safeguarding for minors, the vulnerable and all volunteers.

Our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) has started. We have 8 catechumen and 9 of their children to receive Sacraments at Easter time.

I had adoration and procession with the Blessed Sacrament at Bishop Ryan School to bless the school and to usher in the new school year. Moreover, we have constituted a new Chaplaincy team with student representatives from each grade to help minister to the students in a transformative way. We look forward to successful faith engagements.

Hunger and homelessness are ever-present reality in our community. On a typical day, 140 households are at risk for homelessness; 53 seniors will seek help at a food bank. In Hamilton, 1 in 5 people experiences hunger every day and the risk continues to grow. (Hamilton Hunger Report 2022).

Our Annual CWL FALL FOOD DRIVE for DE MAZENOD DOOR program at St. Patrick's Church and Stoney Creek Community Food Bank will start the weekend of September 23/24 running to October 5, 2023 so that delivery can be made on October 6th! Donations of nonperishable food can be dropped off at our Church and placed in the donation boxes found at the Front Entrance and at the Side Church doors. Most needed items are ground coffee, powdered coffee whitener, sugar, hot chocolate, juice crystals, canned vegetables, salty snacks, fruit cups, cereal bars, ziploc sandwich bags, styrofoam cups/lids or a monetary donation to sponsor one of their Friday BBQ's.
