Dear Parishioners,

We are happy to welcome our new associate Pastor, Fr. Dominic Thomas, CMI, into our parish family. I am including here some information about him.



Fr. Dominic Thomas, born on April 24th, 1964, is a member of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI) congregation, belonging to St. John's CMI Province in Bijnor, Uttar Pradesh, India. He was ordained as a priest on January 6th, 1997.

He holds a Master of Arts (MA) in English from Hemwati Nadan Behuguna Garwal University, India(2000), and a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) from Central Garwal

University, India (2003). Fr. Dominic is a registered lawyer and member of the Supreme Court Bar Association in New Delhi, practicing law at the Supreme Court of India.

In 2008, he obtained a Master of Social Work (MSW) from the University of Mumbai, India, and in 2018, he earned a Diploma in Development Leadership from Coady International Institute, St. Francis Xavier University, Antigonish, Nova Scotia, Canada.

Fr. Dominic has served in various roles, including as a regional secretary of CEVA (Cyriac Ellias Voluntary Association) NRO, New Delhi, coordinating projects in 21 NGOs across India, with collaboration with the German government. He has also served as Director of Chavara Seva Samaj (CSS) NGO, Manager of St. Thomas School, and Parish Priest at St. Thomas Church in the Diocese of Meerut.

He has managed St. Mary's School in Gadarpur, Uttarakhand, India, and served as a Parish Priest at Carmel Church, Gadarpur, in the Diocese of Bareilly. Fr. Dominic has also worked as Director/ Priest In – Charge of Amal Ashram Mission Station in Gopeshwar, Uttarakhand, India, where he engaged in relief and rehabilitation efforts following an earthquake.

In 2021-2023, Fr. Dominic had the opportunity to work as an Assistant Parish Priest in the Archdiocese of Santare'm – Brazil, enjoying his experience working in the South American Amazon Region. He looks forward to sharing his ministry and experiences with his parish community.










The CWL would like to thank all members who were able to attend this year's Spring Regional meeting. Your support was greatly appreciated.
