Dear Family:

We thank God for the many blessings He is pouring unto our parish family.

One Heart One Soul Final Projects: There are two planned projects left to be completed in connection to One Heart One Soul. The two projects are (1) construction of a bell tower and (2) erection of a Digital Sign. The Finance and Building Council has approved a best option quote to proceed with and complete the OHOS planned projects. The Bell Tower will cost \$100.000 and the Digital Sign will cost \$38.000. We hope to begin these projects soon, funding them from our campaign funds. Presently, we have about \$62,853 in the **OHOS campaign account**. We anticipate that more donations will be paid to complete people's pledges. We hope that the bells will remind us of faith and inspire us to continue to proclaim it in our community. The Digital sign will be important to announce our presence in the community to draw more people to our church and to also inform the public about our events and activities. I must mention that some of our parishioners have agreed to contribute their time, expertise and materials towards these projects to help save costs.

Other Projects: We intend to update our Parish hall, kitchen and washrooms. Funds from our upcoming Pasta Supper (June 8, @ 6pm) and Porchetta sales will be used for these projects. Some of our parishioners have volunteered their time, expertise and labour to help save costs. We shall keep you updated on these projects.

Vocations Committee: Sign up to join our newly-formed Vocations Committee to pray for, encourage and support our young people to become priests, brothers and nuns.

Weekday Mass and Friday adorations: Please remember to attend a weekday mass and also to spend time visiting the Blessed Sacrament for adoration. Kindly check our bulletin for the Mass and adoration times.
